Maggie's registered office is at Maggie's, The Gatehouse, 10 Dumbarton Rd, Glasgow G11 6PA. Baltic's registered office is at Baltic Centre For Contemporary Art, Gateshead Quays, South Shore Road, Gateshead, Tyne & Wear NE8 3BA.

By agreeing to participate in this event you accept there are certain terms and conditions to participation set by Maggie's x Baltic which are set out in full below:-

(5) If for any reason you or a group member are not able to take part, all sponsorship forms and money collected must be forwarded to Maggie's and Baltic via Givewheel and will not be refunded.

(6) Maggie's and Baltic have no responsibility to ensure that you are fit for your fundraising activity; you must ensure that you have the appropriate level of fitness to take on your challenge. You must confirm that, to the best of your knowledge, you are currently in a good state of health and that you will not take part in a physical challenge unless you are in a good state of health at the time. If you have any health concerns at any time about taking part, you should speak to your doctor.

(7) You / your team are all taking part in the Event and fundraising at your own risk. Maggie's and Baltic will not have responsibility for any risk, loss or costs which you incur in connection with the Event or fundraising and you will indemnify Maggie's and Baltic, and any persons acting on their behalf for any risk, damages, loss or costs arising as a result of your participation in the Event.

(8) Maggie's and Baltic each hold a standard Employee & Public Liability Insurance and this does not cover any activities you organise as part of your own fundraising. Any challenges or fundraising activity you organise is at your own risk.

(9) You / your group will all comply with Maggie's guidelines when raising fundraising for the Event. Details of these guidelines are available on request.

(10) You / your group must provide Maggie's, Baltic, and any persons acting on their behalf with information, which they may request in connection with the Event.

(11) You confirm that any photographs that you share publicly and/or with Maggie's and Baltic will be usable by Maggie's and/or Baltic in future publicity materials.

(12) You / your group give permission to use your name, photograph, voice, or likeness in any broadcast, telecast, advertising promotion, or other account of this event (including any web-based content, social networking site or external website hosting content on behalf of Maggie's and/or Baltic), or marketing, or promotion for future or similar events and waive any rights of privacy that you may have in that regard.
