

Open Call for Queer & Feminist Zines

Guidelines

Eligibility

- Your publication must qualify as a 'zine' i.e. it must be self-published / DIY / or published by an independent publishing house. We will not accept publications containing advertisements or those published by a traditional publishing house.
- Your zines must align with the themes of Ad Minoliti's exhibition. For more information please visit our website [here](#).
- Your zine must be already in print or available digitally. We are looking for pre-existing zines and will not be able to support the creation or printing of new zines.
- We will not be able to accept dummies. The publication must have been produced and published in a minimum of 4 copies or digitally available online.
- We are able to accept zines that contain swearing or minor nudity. We are not able to accept zines that contain any pornographic content.
- BALTIC stands to denounce racism in all its forms and will not accept any work that communicates any form of racism.

Further Guidance

- We will accept publications in all languages from all over the world, but please note that the majority of visitors to BALTIC are English speaking.
- We will accept digital only zines. These may also be printed in-house for display, subject to the maker's approval.
- We can only accept one copy of your zine for display during the exhibition. This will be for display only, zines will not be for sale.

- We will not be able to return zines to the owners following the close of the exhibition. All zines in suitable condition will be kept in [BALTIC zine collection](#) or donated to local zine libraries.
- We are able to spend a maximum of £20 per zine plus postage.
- If your zine is selected you will be notified by 15th September. Due to the expected high volume of entries, we are unable to offer individual feedback if unsuccessful.
